**FACILITIES:** Fifty-meter course. Controlled temperatures. Eight lanes with non-turbulent lane lines. Electronic timing system. Large spectator seating area, swimmers rest area and diving well available for warm-up and cool down. The venue is certified. Pool depth at the start end is 10'6" and at the turn end 4'.

**ELIGIBILITY:** This meet is open to all registered USA Swimming athletes. Age as of the first day of the meet, June 4, 2010 will determine eligibility for an age group.

**DISABILITIES:** Chesapeake Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Please alert the Meet Director to any accommodations that may be required at the entry deadline.

**FORMAT:**

The meet will consist of 4 sessions. 1 session scheduled for Friday afternoon, 2 sessions on Saturday and 1 session on Sunday. All events listed for each session are OPEN EVENTS. ALL events are timed finals events. All individual events will be seeded together by gender but separated for scoring by the specified age groups. Ribbons will be given in the following age groups: 8-U, 9,10,11,12. There will be no relays. Team scoring will be provided and will include the following age brackets: 8-U, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-18 and Senior. The team with the highest total points excluding the host club will receive the 1<sup>st</sup> place Visiting Team Trophy

The 400 Free, the 400 IM, 800 Free and the 1500 Free will be swum fast to slow, alternating women and men. On Sunday the 800/1500 Free will be swam as follows: The fastest heat of women’s 800 Free followed by the fastest heat of the Men’s 800 Free. Then the fastest heat of the Women’s 1500 Free followed by the fastest heat of the Men’s 1500 Free and so forth. A POSITIVE CHECK IN IS REQUIRED FOR ALL THE EVENTS LISTED IN THIS PARAGRAPH. FAILURE TO SHOW AFTER COMPLETING A POSITIVE “CHECK IN” WILL RESULT IN THE LOSS OF THE NEXT INDIVIDUAL EVENT. AFTER THE CLOSING OF THE POSITIVE CHECK IN PERIOD EACH EVENT WILL BE DECK SEEDED.

All of the sprint events 50 meters by stroke will be started from the deep end of the pool and swam toward the turn (or scoreboard) end of the pool.

Participants swimming time trials are instructed to provide their own timers.

**WARM UP**

Daily swimmer counts permitting, Teams assigned the earlier warm-up period will alternate with the second warm-up period per session.

**INFORMATION:**

OKS and OCCC warm-up procedures will be followed. Coaches will maintain control of all activities in their warm-up lanes.

**STARTS and SPRINTS:**

Starts and Sprints will be conducted at the same time as referenced above. **Lanes 1&8 will be dedicated to pace work, Lanes 2&3 and 6&7 will be dedicated to starts with general warm-up continuing in Lanes 4&5.** During sprints, swimmers will start from the deep end, exit the pool at the far end, and walk back to the start end. Lane assignments for warm-ups will be given to Team Representatives at least 24 hours prior to the meet. Warm-up information will be posted at the Clerk of Course area and the athlete bleacher area. Any swimmer without a coach of record will be assigned to warm-up with the host team.

**ENTRY LIMITS: Individuals:** Five (5) individual events per day including time trials. The maximum number of individual events for the meet will be limited to 14. Time trials count against the maximum number of daily individual events. Entries will be limited to the first 3600 individual events. It is suggested that individual time trial events be limited to a maximum of 3 events for the meet.

**DECK ENTRIES:** Deck entries will be accepted and swimmers will be inserted in the first available lane, in order of deck entries received. There will be a maximum of, 1 additional heat a” 0 Heat” created to accommodate deck entries. **Deck entries for the listed distance events will be accepted.**

**DECK ENTRY CLOSING SCHEDULE** On Friday Deck entries will close at 4:00 PM  
Saturday AM session: Deck entries will close at 8:30 AM  
Sunday AM session: Deck entries will close at 8:30 AM  
Saturday PM session: Deck entries close at 5:00 PM

**POSITIVE CHECK IN** Positive check in for Friday’s 400 Free closes at 4:00 pm.  
Positive check in for Saturday’s 400 IM closes at 8:30 am. Positive Check in for the Sunday 800 Free and 1500 Free will close at 8:30 am.

**ENTRIES:** If a team's total entries cause the meet total to exceed 3600 entries, that team's entries will be rejected. Entries will be considered according to the order of the electronic postmark. Teams whose entries are not accepted because the limit is exceeded will be notified by e-mail, and the fees will be returned.

**ENTRY FORMS:** All entries should be submitted via electronic format. Files compatible with Hy-Tek Meet Manager e.g. Cl2, Sd3, hyv format is the preferred procedure. . Any handwritten or printed entries must indicate the swimmer’s name, sex, age, USAS#, event #., and time for each event .All entry times must be in long course meters. A NO TIME for an event will be accepted. All entry files must include the entry chair’s name, phone #, and e-mail contact information. Include the contact information of whom to send warm-up and final results. Each entry file will be followed up with an entry report for your review and confirmation. Coaches or a team representative must certify that all swimmers entered on the team roster are members of USA Swimming or have applied for membership by sending the appropriate application to the club's registration chairman or the OKS Registration Chairman before the first day of the meet.

Each team should make one check payable to: CHESAPEAKE SWIM CLUB or CSC for all entry fees. No individual checks will be accepted. Mail to above supplied address. Do not send any mail requiring signature confirmation for delivery.

**ENTRY FEES:** Entry fees are \$3.00 for individual events (62.5% or \$1.86 goes to OKS Aquatic Fund) . There is a \$3.00 swimmer surcharge for the OKS Reserve Fund. Additionally, there will be a pool rental surcharge of 12.00 per swimmer. Total surcharge per swimmer is \$15.00. Time trials will be offered under Sanction # OK10-033 at the end of each session, if time allows. It is suggested that the number of individual time trial events not exceed 3 for the duration of the meet. Deck entry individual event fees are \$6.00 with \$3.72 going to the OKS Aquatic Fund. TIME TRIAL entry fees will be \$3.00 with

\$1.86 going to the OKS Aquatic Fund. Make checks payable to the CHESAPEAKE SWIM CLUB or CSC. **NO INDIVIDUAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED, ONLY ONE CHECK FROM EACH CLUB.**

- ENTRY DEADLINE:** **ENTRIES MUST BE IN THE HANDS OF THE MEET DIRECTOR NO LATER THAN 6:00PM THURSDAY MAY 28, 2010. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED!!! CHESAPEAKE SWIM CLUB WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE INCLUSION OF ANY ENTRIES DELIVERED TO SOMEONE OTHER THAN THE MEET DIRECTOR.** Coaches must submit copies of their current certification, including USA Swimming, first aid, CPR and coach's safety training with their entries.
- AWARDS:** Ribbons will be given for the first eight (8) places in each of the following age groups: 8-under, 9, 10, 11, and 12. The team with the most points excluding the host club will be awarded the "Visiting Team Trophy" at the conclusion of the meet.
- SCORING:** For the purposes of the team scoring, individual events will be scored as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> -9 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> -7 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> -6 points, 4<sup>th</sup> - 5 points, 5<sup>th</sup> - 4 points, 6<sup>th</sup> -3 points, 7<sup>th</sup> - 2 points, 8<sup>th</sup> - 1 point. Points will be awarded in the following age groups: 8-under, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-18 and Senior.
- RULES:** The 2010 USA Swimming rules and the OKS Policy and Procedures Manual will govern the meet. **ALL EVENTS ARE TIMED FINALS.**
- SCRATCHES:** This will be a preseeded meet for all events except for the positive check in 1500 Free, 800 Free, 400 Free, and 400 IM. These events will be deck seeded after the positive check in period closes. Failure to show for a positive checked in event will result in the forfeiture of the swimmers next individual event. It will be the swimmer's responsibility to report to their assigned heat and lane.
- FINAL RESULTS:** In accordance with OKS guidelines, final results will be posted on the OKS website ([www.oks.org](http://www.oks.org)). Results of each day's events will be posted on the CSC web site. [www.chesapeakeswimclub.org](http://www.chesapeakeswimclub.org) Complete results will be posted following the meet on the same site. All teams in attendance will be e-mailed complete results after the conclusion of the meet. Each team in attendance will be e-mailed a results file for Team Manager following the conclusion of the meet. Individuals may order copies of the final results at \$10 per copy by leaving their name and address with the Clerk of Course.
- HEAT SHEETS:** A list of all entrants with their times by event, heat and lane assignment for each day will be on sale for \$5.00 each. Deck seeded events will be shown in psych sheet format in the meet program. After deck seeding the distance events, a copy of the heat and lane assignments for athletes will be posted in the spectator area for visitors to access.
- CONCESSIONS:** A concession area will be available.
- MERCHANDISE:** A full supply of swim merchandise will be available for purchase.
- HOSPITALITY:** There will be a hospitality area available for officials and coaches working the Competition.
- SAFETY:** Activities in the pool area, which may result in injury, are prohibited. Safety marshals will be appointed to monitor the activities of swimmers and spectators during warm-

ups and the meet. They are empowered by the safety rules of OKS to enforce the safety procedures governing this meet. Repeated violations or activities that are considered to be sufficiently dangerous may result in ejection from the meet. The use of camera phones for photographic purposes while in the locker rooms is strictly prohibited.

**POOL DECK  
ACCESS:**

Access to the pool/deck area will be limited to athletes, coaches, officials, Timers and OKS certified representatives working the meet. Swimmers failing to comply with the above safety rules are subject to disqualification and /or expulsion from the meet at the discretion of the meet Referee. The walkway at pool deck level on the spectator side must be kept clear at all times. **Parents wishing to observe the competition must do so from the spectator area. Non-Athlete Registration cards do NOT grant parents access to the pool deck at any time.** Coaches must wear proof of current CPR, First Aid, and Coaches Safety Certification while on deck.

**CODE OF  
CONDUCT:**

**Any individual who exhibits behavior of a threatening, abusive or derogatory manner toward an official or a member of the meet operations committee is subject to immediate removal and further expulsion from the meet. Coaches will be notified of the actions of their respective team's parents. Any one found to be misrepresenting themselves as a certified coach will be removed from the deck.**

**LIABILITY:**

In granting this sanction, it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming Inc., Oklahoma Swimming Inc., all officials, the Chesapeake Swim Club, and Oklahoma City Community College shall be free from any and all liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct ion of the meet. Damage to the facility, when proven, will cause the offending swimmer or swimmers, if unattached, or the offending swimmer's club if attached to be accountable for repairs.
